THE MAJOR POLICIES AND PROGRAMS

that are fueling California's green transportation economy are the following:

AB 32 Cap and Trade:
Puts a statewide, declining cap on tons of carbon dioxide emissions, including those from transportation fuels

Low Carbon Fuel Standard:
Requires a reduction in carbon intensity of transportation fuels of 10 percent by 2020

Governor Brown's ZEV Action Plan:
Sets forth a roadmap to get 1.5 million zero emission vehicles on California roads by 2025

Pavley Clean Car Standards:
Reduces greenhouse gas emissions in new passenger vehicles starting in 2009 with a total reduction of 30 percent by 2016

State-Sponsored Incentive Programs:
Legislation like AB 118 and AB 8 spurs investment in alternative fuels, clean vehicles, and in-state industry growth
