MOTION TO HOLD CASE IN ABEYANCE**

Petitioners National Coalition for Advanced Transportation (Case No. 19-1242); Calpine Corporation, Consolidated Edison, Inc., National Grid USA, New York Power Authority, and Power Companies Climate Coalition (Case No. 19-1245); and Advanced Energy Economy (Case No. 19-1249) (collectively, "Industry Petitioners"), in the interest of avoiding repetition and to conserve the resources of the Court and the parties, hereby support and fully join in the State and Municipal Petitioners' and Public-Interest Petitioners' respective motions to hold this case in abeyance, filed on December 26, 2019.
